

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

GRAND CHAMPION SELECT

When quality warrants, after Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex are awarded, a Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) may be chosen from the remaining Champions (Non-Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOB are eligible). WD or WB are not eligible. (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 3, Section 14, Effective 5-12-10)

AWARDS OF MERIT

The judge, at his/her discretion, may choose up to three (3) of the Best of Breed Entries to receive an Award of Merit (excluding the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch winners). An Award of Merit acknowledges those Ridgebacks exhibiting qualities that the judge feels exemplify an exceptional specimen of the breed.

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER CLASS ELIGIBILITY

For non-champion dogs at least 6 months of age. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. Entry is limited to exhibitors who have never been a professional handler, an AKC-approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13 of the AKC Dog Show Rules). Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributes rate cards, or otherwise advertise or represent themselves as handling dogs for pay.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

VETERAN DOG, 7 years & older VETERAN BITCH, 7 years & older

A neutered male may enter the Veteran Dog Class & a spayed bitch may enter the Veteran Bitch Class.

1st place Veteran Dog & 1st place Veteran Bitch compete for Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

*STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog <u>may</u> be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition, but <u>MUST</u> be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get <u>MUST</u> be entered in one of the regular conformation classes or for Best of Breed Competition. No Stud Dog or his Get may be shown as a part of another unit. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed.

*BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as the Stud Dog Class, substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get." NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

BRACE CLASS – Each Brace shall be composed of two (2) Rhodesian Ridgebacks with at least one common owner, to be shown in the ring at the same time. The dogs comprising a brace must be named at the time of entry. The entry form for each dog entered as a part of a brace that is already entered in a regular conformation class or Best of Breed MUST be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes - "Brace Class."

SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION - ALL SHOWS

Eligibility: This Sweepstakes is open to all Rhodesian Ridgebacks, who, on the day of the show, will be at least six months and under eighteen months of age. Professional handlers may handle only their own dogs or dogs they have bred. Champions of record can be shown. Classes to be divided by sex and age. Sweepstake Classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes. Indicate "Sweepstake & Age Division" in the Additional Classes space.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Puppy Dogs, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.
Puppy Dogs, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.
Dogs, 12 mos. & under 18 mos.
The six class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes & Best Opposite in Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

Eligibility: This Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Rhodesian Ridgebacks, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 7 yrs. of age. Neutered males and spayed bitches are eligible for Veteran Sweepstakes. Judging will be held prior to regular classes. A dog **DOES NOT** have to be entered in the Regular Classes at this show. Indicate "Sweepstake & Age Division" in the Additional Classes space.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Veteran Dogs, 7 yrs. and under 9 yrs.
Veteran Dogs, 9 yrs. and under 11 yrs.
Veteran Dogs, 11 yrs. and older

Veteran Bitches, 7 yrs. and under 9 yrs.
Veteran Bitches, 9 yrs. and under 11 yrs.
Veteran Bitches, 11 yrs. and older

The six class winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes & Best Opposite in Veteran Sweepstakes.

SWEEPSTAKES AND VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES MONEY PRIZES

All entry money in each class will be divided as follows. All prize money is paid in the ring to the person handling the dog. *Any undistributed funds revert to the Club.*

- 25% of total Sweepstakes fees will be retained by the club for expenses.
- First Place 30%, Second Place 20%, Third Place 15%, Fourth Place 10%.

Rally Trial for All AKC Hound Breeds. Move-ups allowed. Entries Must Include Dog's Jump Height.

REGULAR CLASSES

Novice A & B, Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Masters

All AKC Hounds are welcome at these trials. All Hounds will be judged once in their respective classes. Placements will be awarded as an All AKC Hound event. A second set of placements will be awarded as an only Rhodesian Ridgeback event.

RIBBON PRIZES

One set of ribbons will be awarded for the All AKC Hound trials.

A second set of ribbons will be awarded for the Rhodesian Ridgeback trial.

(QUALIFYING SCORE REQUIRED FOR ALL PRIZES)

A Complete list of Trophy Donors will be listed in the catalog.

REFUND FOR BITCHES IN SEASON IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: If a bitch comes into season after entries close, a refund of all but \$10.00 will be issued to the listed owner of the bitch, provided a written statement from a veterinarian is presented to the show secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of regular class judging.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP - ALL SHOWS

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 10 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:

- Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show.

For permanent possession, it must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog or bitch, nor at consecutive shows. Name of winning Ridgeback and date will be engraved. Retired by GCHP Diablo's Back Alley Brawler CGC, rededicated to OCRRC in his honor.

The Diablo Challenge Trophy ~ Offered by Nancy Faville, this trophy is a limited edition bronze, "Eternal Flame", by artist Heather Beaty of Prescott, Arizona, for competition at OCRRC Specialty Shows only for Best of Breed. For permanent possession, it must be won three times by the identical ownership, not necessarily with the same dog or bitch, nor at consecutive shows. Name of winning Ridgeback and date will be engraved

Best of Opposite Sex:
