

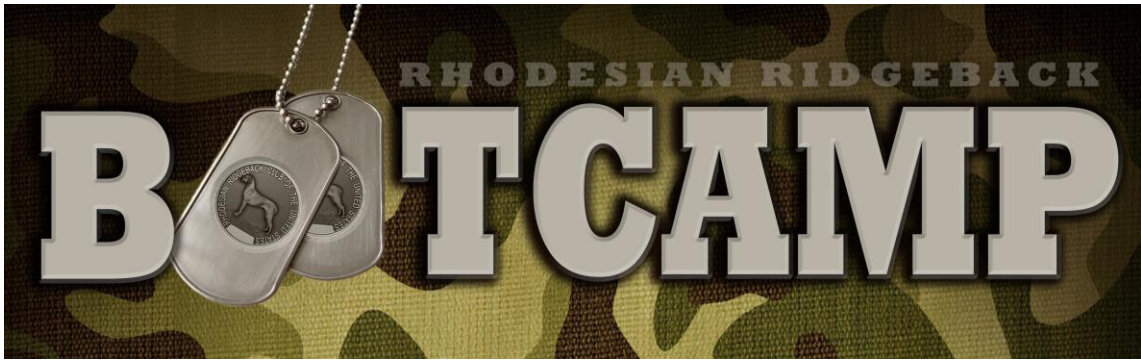
The Education Committee of the Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of the US (RRCUS) is committed to providing education of our breed to the public, current and aspiring Ridgeback breeders and owners, RRCUS members, Regional Club members and Ridgeback enthusiasts. With that goal in mind, RRCUS launched Rhodesian Ridgeback Boot Camp in 2013 and has held several successful programs across the country.

*Now, one is happening in your area! It all takes place Saturday, March 9th, 2019 at The Orange Empire Dog Club*, sponsored by the Orange Coast Rhodesian Ridgeback Club (OCRRC).

We are proud to announce Danielle Sand VMD, Susan Ralston, VMD and Mary Lynne Elliot will be our presenters. They are all long-time RRCUS members, and former RRCUS Board members with Mary Lynne as our former RRCUS President. They are also breed mentors and advisors for Judges' Study group at RRCUS National Specialties.

#### **SCHEDULE • SATURDAY March 9, 2019 (all times except starting time are approximate)**

- 8:00 Facility opens for set up.
- 8:30 am Check in. Plan to crate your dog during the classroom portion of the day. Dogs must be crated or on leash at all times. No X-Pens allowed. Maximum 20 dogs (see details below)
- 9:00 am RRCUS Education Committee Breed Presentation  
This is the video and power point program that is presented to potential judges who are seeking to add Rhodesian Ridgebacks to their list of breeds. It addresses some breed history (with footage of a working RR at Kruger National Park) as well as an explanation of our breed standard with visual examples.
- 10:30 am Break to check on dogs, etc.
- 11:00 am Canine Anatomy and Structure  
An explanation of how the knowledge of correct canine structure is necessary for understanding performance ability as well as for improving the quality of our breed. A physical canine skeleton is used for this part of the presentation.



- 12:00 pm POTLUCK lunch and social hour - please bring a dish to share. You will be asked to indicate what you plan to bring when you submit your registration. In this way we won't have 20 desserts and no sandwiches. Meet new friends, share stories and enjoy your hounds!
- 1:00 pm Movement demonstrations and handling class
- 2:00 pm Questions and discussion

This program is for you if you:

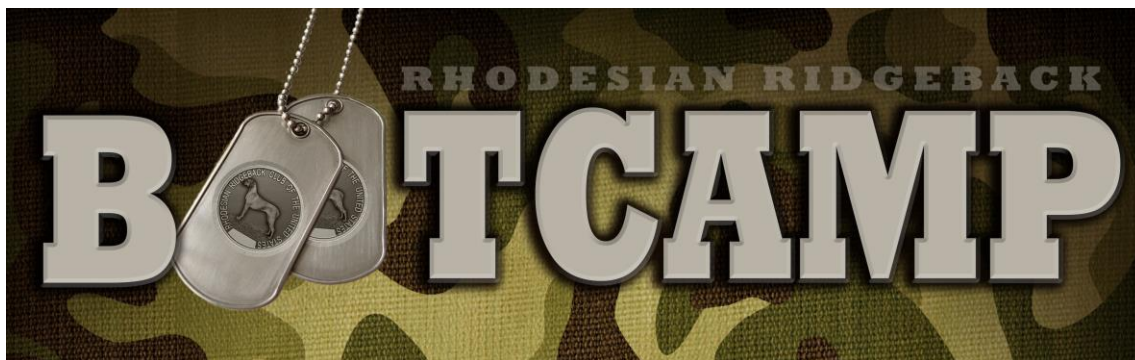
- are new to the breed and desire to learn more

## EXECUTION

OCRRC members will be given first preference then we will accept additional RRs on a first come first serve basis, as needed. We will notify you after the closing dates if you should bring your dog.

**If we reach our maximum number of dogs, you may still attend.** We have room for and welcome attendees in addition to those with the 20 demo Ridgebacks and their handlers.

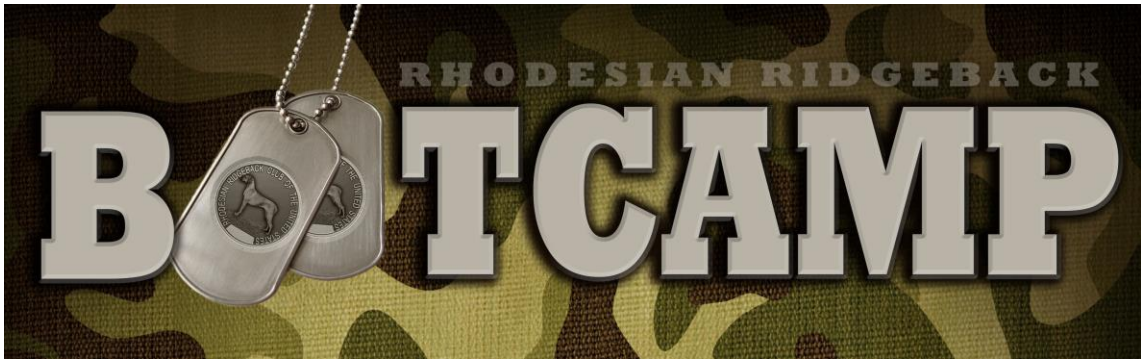
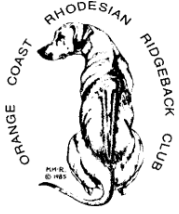
## TACTICAL GEAR

Once you're confirmed as an attendee you will be expected to bring or be responsible for:

- Dish to share for pot luck lunch
- For those notified they are permitted to bring a dog, the dogs should be at least six months of age and must be up to date on health, rabies, vaccinations/titer, etc. Handlers are responsible for:
  - Crate – Plan to crate your dog during the classroom portion of the day. Note: dogs must be crated or on leash at all times. No X-Pens allowed.
  - Water and bait for your dog
  - Clean-up and behavior of your dog
  - Leads/leashes/collars; show lead (if you have one)

### From Orange County

55 North to the 91 East

Merge onto the 15 North

Take exit 106A onto CA 60 East towards Riverside

Take exit 48 (Valley Way)

At offramp make a left onto Mission Blvd

Make a left onto Valley Way (under the 60)

Valley Way becomes Armstrong Road and then bends slight left and becomes Locust Avenue

Take Locust to Santa Ana Avenue. Make a right.

OEDC Clubhouse will be on your right.

### From the South

I-15 North to

I-215 North

the I-215 becomes CA 60 past UC Riverside

Continue on the CA-60 to

Market Street in Riverside

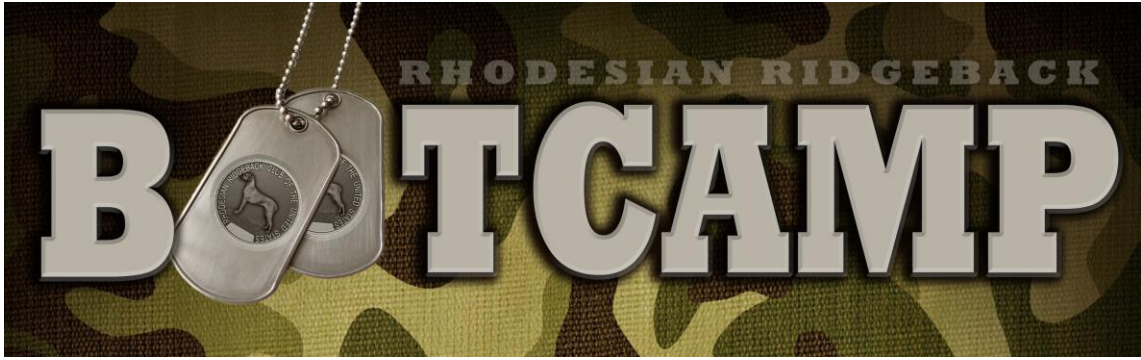
Take exit 52A from CA-60 W
